# Competing for the Conrad Daniels Trophy

This is annual, best of 3 Chicago style (501/Cricket/301) tournament. Designed to self manage – you'll get your next opponent and have three to four weeks to coordinate and play the match. This should be easy enough to do on Thursdays prior to regular league matches at one of the league bars. Winner moves on. When we get to the top 8, we'll play a best of 5 version (501x2/ Cricketx2/ 301).

#### Schedule:

Round 1: Play by February 11

Round 2: Play by March 3

Round 3: Play by March 24

Round 4: Play by April 14...

After round 4, we will be in the Top 8. It is still being worked on to have the Top 8 play out the finals all in one night. More information to follow.

#### Match format:

Best of 3. 501 is the first game, Cricket is second game, 301 DI/DO is the 3<sup>rd</sup> game if necessary.

Diddle for start each leg. Loser of the previous game decides to throw first or second for cork. We will use PDC rules. EVERY dart gets pulled. The dart either scores as OUT, SINGLE BULL or DOUBLE BULL. There is no measuring. If the two players are tied, it reverses order, and someone must shoot a BULL or DOUBLE BULL to win the diddle.
